• Let the school know of any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child's learning, behaviour or ability to do homework, so this can then be resolved quickly.

- Attend meetings with my child's teachers to learn how to help move my child on in their learning.

• Support and work with the school to ensure that the high expectations of pupils are maintained.
