

Computing - E safety

This week the Leys have been celebrating E-safty week, this has coincided with e-safety day, in the school we have been focusing on this years theme which is 'Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online'. Across the school we have been exploring how we can start a conversation if we see something that upsets up online. KS1 have read a wonderful book by Amy Lockwood called Hanni and the Magic Window, KS2 have been exploring all the things that they can use the internet for and how to talk about what they find in an appropriate way. This week we have also spoken about the SMART rules making sure everyone knows the rules that we follow at The Leys to keep us all safe online. Below is some of the work that KS1 have been undertaking this week helping use learn about the importance of talking to a trusted adult if we have any worries.
