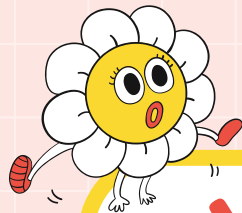




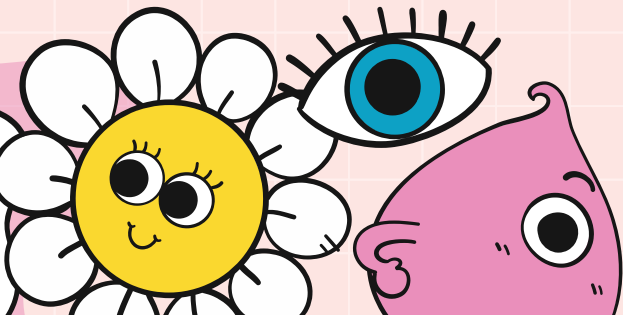

CURRICULUM

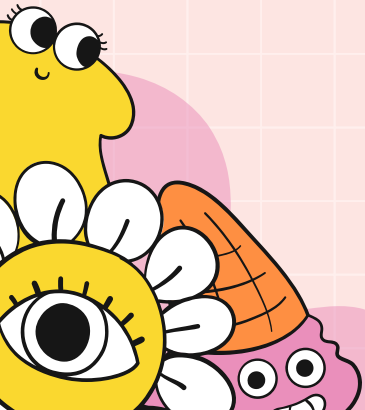
What we cover in Year 5
