WELLBEING



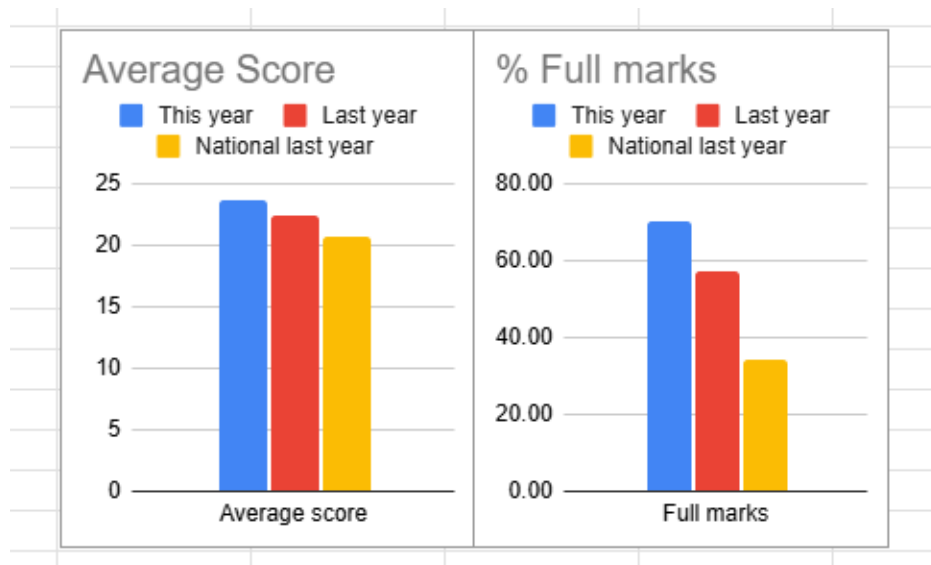
