

Positive Regard

This term we are training all our staff about Positive Regard. This covers a range of strategies to support children's wellbeing and behaviour in school. Including current science around how the brain works, strategies to build positive relationships and to de-escalate children who are struggling to manage their emotions. As part of this work all the children from Year 1-6 are learning about the Hand Model of the Brain and what happens when we Flip Our Lid which can be linked to the **Zones of Regulation** as shown in the poster here. Stay Phone-Free


We kindly ask all parents and carers to stay off their phones when dropping off or collecting children. Being phone-free helps:
