Science	<p><u>This half term our topic is Animals, including humans:</u> Key Vocabulary- life cycle, metamorphosis, naturalist, reproduction</p>	
Computing	<p><u>This half term we are focusing on Spreadsheets.</u> Key Vocabulary- axis/axes, budget, continuous data, conversion, forecast, formula, income, function, line graph, meteorologist, plot/plotting, trend</p>	
Geography	<p><u>This half term our topic is Marvellous Maps:</u> Key Vocabulary- ordnance survey, location, coordinates, physical features, man-made features.</p>
