This week in school we have been celebrating World Autism Day. Autism isn't a mental health problem, but if you're autistic you may be more likely to experience a mental health problem. Data suggests that a quarter of the general population have problems with their mental health at some point in their life. In autistic people, this number is much higher with almost 80% of autistic adults experiencing mental health issues during their lives. For many people with autism, mental illness can be more difficult to recognise and treat effectively. It's widely recognised that much more needs to be done to support autistic people with their mental health but getting the basics right (exercise, diet and sleep) is an important start.
