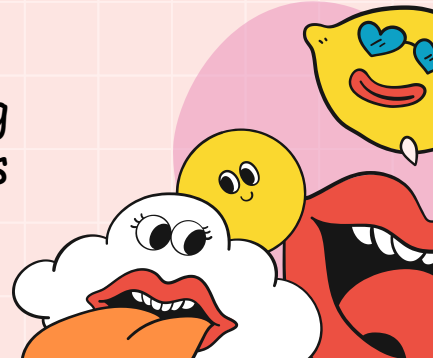
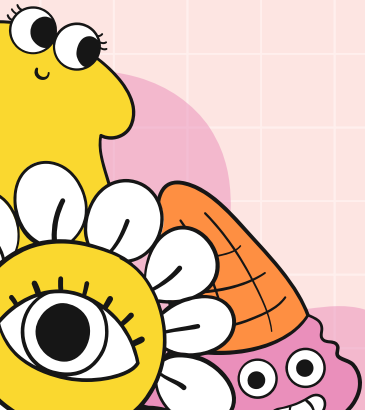


WRITING
