Enrichment tasks	The Reading Marathon: Read at least two books from a "Year 7 Recommended" list. Moving from primary to secondary often involves a "reading dip," so keeping the habit alive is crucial. Worry Jar vs. Goal Jar: Write down three things you are nervous about and three things you are excited to try (like a new club or science experiments). Discussing the "nerves" out loud often makes them feel smaller.
