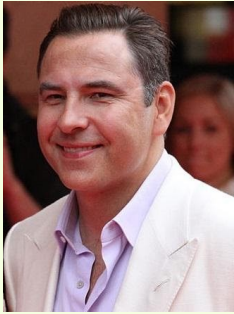

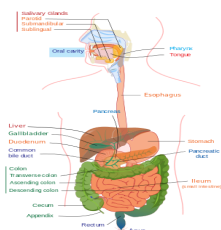
Which one is the odd one out? Explain your answer.
